Benefits of Membership in Piedmont Regional Library System

An addendum to the PRLS Regional Fee Policy APPROVED BY PRLS BOARD APRIL 2021

A Regional Library Office provides much of the "back room" and administrative support for operating libraries in a regional library system. Below are some of the benefits that an independent library would have to fund on its own if not a member of a regional system.

State Aid. In Georgia, only libraries which are part of one of the 60 regional (or county) systems are eligible for state aid. This includes*:

- ✓ Funding for books, technology, and other library materials
- ✓ High speed Internet connections for staff and public access at all locations
- ✓ PINES library catalog and automated circulation system
- ✓ PINES courier service to headquarters location
- ✓ Ability to request items and have them delivered from other PRLS library collections
- ✓ Ability to request items and have them delivered from other PINES library locations
- ✓ Access to state-funded electronic resources such as GALILEO, Mango Language Learning, Learning Express and ERead Kids
- ✓ Paid professional and support staff and regional office operating expenses
- ✓ Funding for new library construction most facilities in PRLS were built with state funds, which pays substantial amounts of the construction costs

Regional Service. Beyond state funding, regional office provides cost savings by sharing the expenses of the following services with other agencies in Banks, Barrow, & Jackson counties.*

- ✓ Regional courier includes delivering PINES materials to all locations
- ✓ Regional outreach service includes service to assisted living centers, senior centers, day care centers and schools throughout the three-county region
- ✓ Technology support includes staffing with expertise in PINES, statistical reporting and troubleshooting; and other IT-related support including hardware/software support of public computers
- ✓ Assistance with book selection and the development of library collections
- ✓ Cataloging of books and other library materials into PINES
- ✓ Processing includes adding book jackets, spine labels, etc. so materials may be shelved correctly and located quickly
- ✓ Access to a regional storytime props collection and professional collection
- ✓ Access to various digital resources including ebooks, e-audiobooks, electronic magazines, and World Book Online
- ✓ Professional advocacy for public libraries at the national, state, and local levels
- ✓ Professional support and training for all library staff including children's services, budgeting, staffing levels, leadership and management, customer service, etc.
